3. Great powers' perspective and influence on structuring the Greater Eurasian space
4. Prospects of Russia-Belarus relations: Theoretical model of the Union State

6. The U.S.-Russia-China triangle in the context of Russia-China rapprochement
7. Russia's asymmetric power and its projection in Eurasia, Europe, Latin America, Africa, and the Middle East
8. Strategic autonomy in the worldwide dimension (with a special focus on European and Asian actors)
9. Theoretical foundations of cybersecurity/informational security. Cyberattacks as international political discourse
